Project title	Construction and development of a completely independent and self-sustainable nursery garden of berries
Sector	Agriculture, Food Industry, Fruit and vegetable
Location	Hotigosce, Bugojno Municipality
Location description	Hotigosce is around 8 kilometres away from Bugojno, 850 meters above the sea level. With its geographical position, climatic conditions, ecologically clean land and air, as well as water from the mountain sources, Hotigosce is an ideal place for the development of organic agricultural farming. Bugojno is a city and municipality located in Central Bosnia. It is situated on river Vrbas, 130 km (81 mi) to the northwest from Sarajevo.
Company description	Repro centre "H&H Fruit" doo Bugojno, as a part of the HEKO doo company, is the leading buyer of berry and forest fruits in BiH. The company has been in existence for 13 years. Today, HEKO has 152 employees; more than 100 seasonal workers, and over 1,000 cooperates with the annual turnover of 10 million euros in 2018.
Project status	In progress
Project description	The project proposes production of different types of berries seedling (raspberry, blackberry, blueberry, currant and gooseberry) in total amount quantities between 1.5 and 2 million seedling per year. The farm is fully operational with existing infrastructure: Building/Stable 1 - 162 m ² ; Building/Stable 2 - 1.135 m ² ; Building/Stable 3 - 140 m ² ; House - 160 m ² ; Weekend cottage - 172 m ² ; House under construction - 160 m ² ; Multifunctional building under construction - 540 m ² ; Courtyard - 1.000 m ² . The planned operating costs for 2020 year are 153,095 EUR, and the projected annual revenue for the same year amounts to 1,124,842 EUR.
