Project title	Construction of distributive system and natural gas distribution for municipalities: Jajce, Donji Vakuf, Bugojno and Gornji Vakuf-Uskoplje
Sector	Infrastructure
Location description	Central Bosnia Canton occupies the central part of BiH with an area of 3.189 km ² or 6.2% area of BiH. It contains 12 municipalities, including Jajce, Donji Vakuf, Bugojno, Gornji Vakuf-Uskoplje, which are the main part of the project.
Project status	Project is ready for Implementation. Feasibility study, Preliminary design and "Versatile application of natural gas" prospectus have been made.
Project description	The project proposes the construction of distributive system and natural gas distribution for the possibility of sustainable energy sources. Main gas pipeline Zenica - Travnik has been constructed and now it is possible to build a natural gas pipeline Travnik - Donji Vakuf with two separate branches. In addition, there is an alternative for main gas pipeline construction from Republic of Croatia with the start point in Split to Gornji Vakuf - Uskoplje. Gasification should be delivered in two phases: Phase one: 18 500 000 EUR & Phase two: 9 500 000 EUR. Deadline for refund: 10 years.
Estimated total investment cost	28 000 000 EUR
Inputs provided by local partner	100 000 EUR - Documentation development (studies, preliminary, and main project).
Inputs required from foreign partner	27 900 000 EUR - Procurement costs of pipes, equipment and construction zone costs, also users' connection to the distribution network.
Form of cooperation with foreign partner	Proposed cooperation is a concession, which will be assigned for a period of 30 years by the DBOT system (Design, Build, Operate, Transfer) or Joint Venture in accordance with the Law on Private public partnership of Central Bosnia Canton.
